ENGLISH

English outcomes continue to support the achievement of our school targets. Speaking and listening enables our students to clarify their ideas, explore issues, solve problems and develop understandings of all Key Learning Areas. Our students develop reading skills, strategies and comprehension through modelled, guided and independent reading experiences. Students develop handwriting, spelling, grammar and writing skills through integrated lessons. In writing, the aim for students is to create cohesive imaginative, informative and persuasive texts. This term Year 1 will be using Bug Club as an online reading program.

MATHEMATICS

The strands of Mathematics are Number and Algebra, Statistics and Probability, and Measurement and Geometry. The process strand, Working Mathematically is embedded into the three strands. All students in Stage 1 participate in differentiated activities which teach students explicit skills and concepts to support learning in numeracy.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY AND GEOGRAPHY

Classes will be covering the following units this term: Science: Material and Physical World

Geography: People and Places

CREATIVE ARTS

The strands of Creative Arts are Visual Arts, Music, Drama and Dance. This term Year 1 and Year 2 will participate in whole grade singing and music.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, HEALTH and PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students deepen their knowledge and understanding of Road and Home Safety this term through class PDH programs. Stage 1 will continue to participate in sport on a Thursday focusing on athletics skills leading up to our athletics carnival in Term 3.
