Advice for Parents

Students learn to write lower case letters using the NSW foundation handwriting font at school. Students learn to correctly form letters in order to write clearly and legibly ready to learn cursive writing in the later schooling years. You can help your child by using the letter formation tracing guide at home for your child to practise correct letter writing.

Activities to Try at Home

Tracing Sheet-practise writing lower case letters correctly with the tracing guide below. Have your child start at the dot and follow the numbers showing which way to go. Most letters are written by starting at the top (a, b, c, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, p, q, r, s, t, u, v, w, x, y, z) Some letters start in the middle (d, e)

Shopping Lists-Have your child help you write the shopping list using correct letter formation. At school the letters look like this:

a b c d e f g h i j k l m n o p q r s t u v w x y z
